

**MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING FOR THE
TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, GRANT COUNTY, WI
Tuesday, January 11, 2022, 6:00 PM
Town Hall, 15070 County G, Muscoda WI**

Present: Chairman Brian Johnsrud, Supervisor Randall Foreman, Supervisor Donald Hrubes.

Call to order. The Chairman called the meeting to order.

Minutes of last meeting. The Clerk presented the minutes of the last meeting to the Board. Motion by Foreman and second by Hrubes to accept the minutes of the previous meeting; motion carried voice vote.

Treasurer's report. The Treasurer presented a financial report. Motion by Foreman and second by Hrubes to accept the Treasurer's financial report; motion carried voice vote.

Paying bills. The Town Board examined the bills presented for payment. Motion by Foreman and second by Hrubes to pay the bills; motion carried voice vote.

Chairman Johnsrud reported on setting up a website for the Town of Castle Rock with John Wells of Webwise Design Marketing who has done so for the Cities of Fennimore and Boscobel as well as other Towns and Villages in the area. This would be an approved use of ARPA funds. The cost would be \$1499 to start and then \$75 per month or \$720 per year if paid in advance. Motion by Foreman and second by Hrubes to authorize the Chairman to set up this website; motion carried voice vote.

Chairman Johnsrud presented an annual request from Scenic Rivers Energy Cooperative to do their utility work on the Town's right of way; all were in favor.

There was discussion on recent snow removal and sanding. The general consensus was that Grass Pro is doing an OK job, that they did some additional sanding in needed areas, and that they are receptive to taking care of Township needs when called on.

Chairman Johnsrud reported that more needed work is being planned for Shemak Road in 2022 and that because of budget restraints Shemak Road would be a multi-year project. He also reported on broadband issues and problems in trying to bring high speed internet to rural areas, the biggest problem being who will pay for bringing the service to area households.

The meeting concluded with the Supervisors working on staffing the Recycling Center on open days.
