

**MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING FOR THE  
TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, GRANT COUNTY, WI  
Tuesday, May 17, 2022, 6:00 PM  
Town Hall, 15070 County G, Muscoda WI**

Present: Chairman Brian Johnsrud, Supervisor Randall Foreman, Supervisor Donald Hrubes.

Call to order. The Chairman called the meeting to order.

Minutes of last meeting. The Clerk presented the minutes of the last meeting to the Board. Motion by Foreman and second by Hrubes to accept the minutes of the previous meeting; motion carried voice vote.

Treasurer's report. The Treasurer presented a financial report. Motion by Hrubes and second by Foreman to accept the Treasurer's financial report; motion carried voice vote.

Paying bills. The Town Board examined the bills presented for payment. Motion by Foreman and second by Hrubes to pay the bills; motion carried voice vote.

Supervisor Hrubes reported that he sold some used culverts for \$10 per foot and that the poorer shape culverts would be sold for \$5 per foot. Chairman Johnsrud reported that there were more bad culverts on Shemak Road than originally thought and had them replaced before the final graveling and sealcoating there.

Chairman Johnsrud reported on the preparations for the Large Trash Day scheduled for Saturday May 21 2022. Two large dumpsters, an appliance dumpster, a tire dumpster, and an e-waste collector.

Chairman Johnsrud reported on Shemak Road work. To save money, not all of the road was pulverized and that hopefully the sections not pulverized will hold up. He reported that he would go with Mike Shemak's recommendation for quarry selection and gravel size and depth. The gravel bill will be about \$80,000, noting that there is hardly any gravel base on the hill part of Shemak Road. The pulverized part will need a double seat coat and that part of the project may exceed money available in this year's budget.

There was discussion on other Town roads in need of work. That now includes Crow Valley Road, Irish Hollow Road, and Hooks Road. Again, there is probably no money in this year's budget to work on them.

The Board discussed traffic volume and noted that Shemak Road and Witek Road are perhaps the two most traveled roads in the Township, that in general farmers are using bigger and heavier machinery currently, and that our Town Roads were not designed to handle the current activity in increased volume and weights.

Kelly Dudley made an appearance and asked for some relief from all the dust coming off Shemak Road. The Board recognized the situation and would look into it.

Adjournment. There was no further business to transact. Motion by Foreman and second by Hrubes to adjourn; the Chairman adjourned the meeting at 6:30 PM.
