

**MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING FOR THE  
TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, GRANT COUNTY, WI  
Tuesday, December 12, 2023, 6:00 PM  
Town Hall, 15070 County G, Muscoda WI**

Present: Chairman Brian Johnsrud, Supervisor Randall Foreman, Supervisor Donald Hrubes.

Call to order. The Chairman called the meeting to order.

Minutes of last meeting. The Clerk presented the minutes of the last meeting to the Board.

Motion by Foreman and second by Hrubes to accept the minutes of the previous meeting; motion carried voice vote.

Treasurer's report. The Treasurer presented a financial report. Motion by Hrubes and second by Foreman to accept the Treasurer's financial report; motion carried voice vote.

Paying bills. The Town Board examined the bills presented for payment. Motion by Hrubes and second by Foreman to pay the bills; motion carried voice vote.

**Public Appearances.** Harold Freymiller was recognized, and he spoke about the ever increasing property tax bills. The Board responded that the Town Board only has authority for the Town taxes part of the property tax bills, all other taxes are pass through taxes. Also that inflation makes it impossible to not increase the Town tax levy each year.

**Supervisor Foreman presented the specs and quote for a Woods 10.51 Flex Wing Mower** for \$17,800 from Ritchie's. Delivery in about two months, payment due on delivery, and a probable 5 – 10% price increase for orders after the first of the year. There was discussion on the mower. Motion by Foreman, second by Hrubes, that we order the mower now. Motion carried with all Board members voting aye.

**Clerk Hrubes presented the election workers for the 2024-2025 election term:** Maureen Vandenbosch, Savannah Drews, Martha Peterson, Helen Stanek, Maria Drews, and Lynnette Shemak. Motion by Hrubes, second by Foreman, that the election workers list be approved; motion carried voice vote.

**Chairman Johnsrud presented a proposed driveway ordinance for discussion.** He noted that there are four new homes going on in the Township at this time. There was discussion on the many terms in the proposal. Board members were asked to review the proposed ordinance, and Clerk Hrubes said he would attempt to get copies of driveway ordinances, if any, from Wingville and Hickory Grove. No action was taken.

Adjournment. There was no further business to transact. Motion by Foreman and second by Hrubes to adjourn; the Chairman adjourned the meeting at 7 PM.
