

ORDINANCE NO. 1997-1

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DEPOSIT, LOADING OR UNLOADING OF LOGS ON HIGHWAY RIGHTS OF WAY IN THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, GRANT COUNTY, WISCONSIN, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, GRANT COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I: It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit or cause to be deposited any logs or timber upon any highway, including both the traveled portion and the right of way of any highway, in the Town of Castle Rock.

Section II: It shall be unlawful for any person to load or unload logs or timber onto or from any vehicle or machinery upon any highway, including both the traveled portion and the right of way of any highway, in the Town of Castle Rock.

Section III: Any person who violates this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$500.00 together with the costs of prosecution. For the first conviction within any calendar year, the penalty as scheduled shall be \$150.00, together with court costs and surcharges. For the second and subsequent convictions within any calendar year, the scheduled forfeiture shall be \$300.00 together with court costs and surcharges.

Section IV: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.
