

**MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING FOR THE
TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, GRANT COUNTY, WI
Tuesday, April 16, 2024, 6:15 PM following the Annual Town Meeting
Town Hall, 15070 County G, Muscoda WI**

Present: Chairman Brian Johnsrud, Supervisor Randall Foreman, absent: Supervisor Donald Hrubes.

Call to order. The Chairman called the meeting to order.

Minutes of last meeting. The Clerk presented the minutes of the last meeting to the Board. Motion by Foreman and second by Johnsrud to accept the minutes of the previous meeting; motion carried voice vote.

Treasurer's report. The Treasurer presented a financial report. Motion by Foreman and second by Johnsrud to accept the Treasurer's financial report; motion carried voice vote.

Paying bills. The Town Board examined the bills presented for payment. Motion by Johnsrud and second by Foreman to pay the bills; motion carried voice vote.

Supervisor Foreman reported that the mower from Ritchie's is in and that a leak problem was noted in their setup, so that is being fixed now.

Chairman presented a contract proposal from Scott Construction for chip seal surfacing on Kohout, Cedar Rock, and Hooks Roads. There was discussion on same. Motion by Foreman, second by Johnsrud, that we approve the contract. Voting aye: Foreman, Johnsrud. The Chairman declared the motion approved.

There was discussion on additional needed road work for 2024: Spring Valley, Shemak, Witek and Neff Roads. The Chairman was authorized to pursue these issues further.

There was discussion on the continuing and worsening unauthorized after hours dumpster dumping, particularly where items that should be recycled are being deposited into the trash dumpsters, a violation of our Recycling Ordinance. The Chairman noted that nearly all surrounding municipalities have their dumpsters fenced or enclosed in a building. There was discussion on same. With reluctance, motion by Johnsrud, second by Foreman, that the Township fence off the Township property. Voting aye: Foreman, Johnsrud. The Chairman declared the motion approved.

The annual large trash day was set for June 15th, 2024.

The Chairman reported on a recent driveway application and permit granted to Todd Aide. It was noted that driveway activity for Esser and Bomkamp would be grandfathered in.

Next meeting. Tuesday, May 14, 2024, 6:00 PM.

Adjournment. There was no further business to transact. Motion by Foreman and second by Johnsrud to adjourn; the Chairman adjourned the meeting at 7 PM.
