

**MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING FOR THE  
TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, GRANT COUNTY, WI  
Tuesday, May 14, 2024, 6:00 PM  
Town Hall, 15070 County G, Muscoda WI**

Present: Chairman Brian Johnsrud, Supervisor Randall Foreman, Supervisor Donald Hrubes.

Call to order. The Chairman called the meeting to order.

The first order of business was to convene the Board of Review for 2024. Since the assessment roll is not yet completed, the Board of Review needs to adjourn to a later date. Motion by Foreman, second by Hrubes, that we adjourn to the second Tuesday of July; motion carried voice vote.

Chairman Johnsrud then called to order the regular monthly Board meeting.

Minutes of last meeting. The Clerk presented the minutes of the last meeting to the Board. Motion by Foreman and second by Hrubes to accept the minutes of the previous meeting; motion carried voice vote.

Treasurer's report. The Treasurer presented a financial report. Motion by Hrubes and second by Foreman to accept the Treasurer's financial report; motion carried voice vote.

Paying bills. The Town Board examined the bills presented for payment. Motion by Hrubes and second by Foreman to pay the bills; motion carried voice vote.

Chairman Johnsrud presented a second chip seal quote from Scott Construction. There is not enough money in the budget to do all the work in this quote and the one approved at the April meeting. There was discussion on which roads need to be taken care of now and which ones could be deferred.

The Board felt that the work for Cedar Rock Road approved in the April chip seal quote could reluctantly be deferred until 2025 for lack of money and that Spring Valley Road needs to be done this year. Motion by Hrubes, second by Foreman, that we approve the second quote provided the Town can get released from the Cedar Rock Road part of the April approved quote; motion carried voice vote.

Clerk Hrubes presented Operator's License applications from Mary L Spurgeon and Michael Patzner. Motion by Foreman, second by Hrubes to grant same; motion carried voice vote.

There was discussion on and preparations for the Large Trash Day set for June 15<sup>th</sup>.

There was discussion on fencing issues for the Town property in connection with the Recycling and Solid Waste programs, specifically that unknown persons are improperly dumping items during closed hours and that some trash is blowing onto the adjacent property. The fencing for this was approved at the April meeting. Now the Board will go ahead with fencing the entrance to the Town property as well as doing a woven wire fencing to attempt to contain blowing trash.

There was discussion on dealing with silo wrap, bale wrap, netting, and other ag plastics brought to the Recycling Center. The Board felt that separate dumpsters for this would be the best route to go. Motion by Foreman, second by Hrubes, that we do separate dumpsters for ag plastics; motion carried voice vote.

Next meeting. Tuesday, June 11, 2024, 6:00 PM.

Adjournment. There was no further business to transact. Motion by Hrubes and second by Foreman to adjourn; the Chairman adjourned the meeting at 7:30 PM.
