

**MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING FOR THE  
TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, GRANT COUNTY, WI  
Tuesday, July 8, 2025, 6:00 PM  
Town Hall, 15070 County G, Muscoda WI**

Present: Chairman Brian Johnsrud, Supervisor Randall Foreman, Supervisor Donald Hrubes.  
Call to order. The Chairman called the meeting to order.

Minutes of last meeting. The Clerk presented the minutes of the last meeting to the Board.  
Motion by Foreman and second by Hrubes to accept the minutes of the previous meeting;  
motion carried voice vote.

Treasurer's report. The Treasurer presented a financial report. Motion by Hrubes and second  
by Foreman to accept the Treasurer's financial report; motion carried voice vote.

Paying bills. The Town Board examined the bills presented for payment. Motion by Hrubes  
and second by Hrubes to pay the bills; motion carried voice vote.

Public appearance by Harold Freymiller who asked for an update on a fencing matter.

Chairman Johnsrud replied that the Town has engaged an attorney to represent the Town in the  
matter and that the attorney has not yet prepared a response. No action was taken.

Supervisor Hrubes reported that the two town mowers were sold for \$5,000.

Chairman Johnsrud presented an amended contract with Scott Construction to reflect new  
priorities in sealcoating. Contract as amended approved by unanimous voice vote.

Clerk Hrubes presented a contract with Grant County for Wisvote Data Entry Services.

Basically this means that Grant County will maintain the state voter registration database for the  
Town for the year 2026. For 2027 the Town will have to maintain the database on its own.

Motion to approve by Hrubes, second by Foreman, motion carried voice vote.

Chairman Johnsrud reported on talks with the Grant County Highway Department for future  
snow removal services. Grant County would provide a driver and truck to be kept at the Town  
shed with backup by the two regular drivers assigned to County G. Hopefully the County will  
present a retainer for Town consideration soon. No action was taken.

There was general discussion on road maintenance issues. No action was taken.

Next meeting. Tuesday, August 12, 2025, 6:00 PM along with Board of Review.

Adjournment. There was no further business to transact. Motion by Foreman and second  
by Hrubes to adjourn; the Chairman adjourned the meeting.
