

**MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING FOR THE  
TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, GRANT COUNTY, WI  
Tuesday, December 9, 2025, 6:00 PM  
Town Hall, 15070 County G, Muscoda WI**

Call to order. The Chairman called the meeting to order.

Present: Chairman Brian Johnsrud, Supervisor Randall Foreman, Supervisor Donald Hrubes.

Minutes of last meeting. The Clerk presented the minutes of the last meeting to the Board.

Motion by Foreman and second by Hrubes to accept the minutes of the previous meeting; motion carried voice vote.

Treasurer's report. The Treasurer presented a financial report. Motion by Hrubes and second by Foreman to accept the Treasurer's financial report; motion carried voice vote.

Paying bills. The Town Board examined the bills presented for payment. Motion by Foreman and second by Hrubes to pay the bills; motion carried voice vote.

Public appearance by Harold Freymiller concerning the "Freymiller Thomas Trust Fence" issue. Chairman Johnsrud replied that there would be a fence viewing for this on Saturday, December 13.

Supervisor Foreman reported on a recent fire department inspection, the EXIT lights need to be fixed/upgraded and that the fire extinguishers need to be inspected.

Neil Michek representing the Highland Ambulance Service was recognized who spoke about the operation of their service, staffing, and challenges. He also spoke about "Updating the Operational Plan" for this service, changing from the Advanced Emergency Medical Technician Level to a Flex Staffing Plan Emergency Medical Technician Level. There was discussion on same. Motion to support the efforts of the Highland Ambulance Service and this Operational Plan as presented by Michek: Motion by Foreman, second by Hrubes. Motion carried, voice vote.

Chairman Johnsrud spoke about roadside brush control and that Mike Shemak was interested in doing some of this work for the Township and that Grant County can do spraying. There was discussion on same, no action was taken.

There was discussion on the turnaround at the end of Prochaska Road and that this needs to be upgraded as the truck and snowplow got stuck there following a recent snowfall.
